Prizewinner of Trudeau Rechearch Foundation in Canada, Philippe POULLAOUEC-GONIDEC is the holder and the founder of the UNESCO Chair in Landscape and Environmental Design at Université de Montreal (Canada). He is also the holder and co-founder of the Chair in Landscape and Environmental Design at Université de Montréal (CPEUM). Landscape architect and shaper of the environment, he is professor at the School of Landscape Architecture at the Université de Montréal which he directed from 1991 to 1996. Philippe POULLAOUEC-GONIDEC is a member of the Sectoral Commission on Natural Sciences, Social and Human of the CCU (Canadian Commission for UNESCO), American Society of Landscape Architects (ASLA), Canadian Association of Landscape Architects (AAPC) and Architecture History Research Institute (IRHA-Canadian Architecture Center). In 2007, he received the Order of Arts and Literature of France.
